


TIME TO “RAISE THE ROOF”!



DEAR TCCC FAMILY,

As you know our roof has been leaking in multiple areas over the last several years. We have patched, coated and reinforced the roofing over the last 5 years or more. However, since it is **30 years old** now the roof is beyond its expected life time, therefore it is **time to replace** it.

What is that going to cost? GOOD QUESTION, thanks for asking! We estimate approximately **\$8,000 for the entire job**, including all materials and possible sheeting that may need to be replaced under the old metal. We hope to do this with volunteer labor – **ONE SECTION at a TIME** (See Image Above).

The picture above shows the sections of the roof that need to be replaced and numbered in order of priority. Four sections at approx. **\$2,000 each section**. Once we have the money for one section we would schedule a time to replace it, and then the same for each

section. This way we can tackle this job in smaller portions, possibly requiring only one day for each section.

NOTICE Sections 3 and 4 are smaller than 1 and 2. However, due to the angles and cutting of the materials needed for 3 & 4 the costs may be about the same.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

AND – ANOTHER WAY YOU CAN HELP:

1. FOR **EACH SECTION** – we need 20 people to give \$100 each.

2. We need “able” volunteers to help replace each section.

- If we need to hire some for this we will, at an added cost.

We hope to have at least sections 1 and 2 done before the snow flies!

THIS IS A FAITH PROJECT! You have the opportunity to step out in faith in giving to the Lord. The amount you give is solely between you and the Lord, and generosity cannot be measured simply by the size of the gift. It's been said: *“It's not how much you give that counts, it's how much you have left!”*
