## Congress issued 15 Prayer \& Thanksgiving Proclamations during the War for Independence

## THANKSGIVING IN AMERICA

"Forasmuch as it is the indispensable duty of all men to adore the superintending Providence of Almighty God; to acknowledge with gratitude their obligation to Him for benefits received and to implore such further blessing as they stand in need of; \& it having pleased Him in His abundant mercy not only to continue to us the innumerable bounties of His common Providence... It is therefore recommended to the legislative or executive powers of these United States, to set apart Thursday, the $18^{\text {TH }}$ day of Dec. next, for the solemn thanksgiving and praise:

## THANKSGIVING IN AMERICA

That with one heart and one voice the good people may express the grateful feelings of their hearts, and consecrate themselves to the service of their Divine Benefactor; and that together with their sincere acknowledgements and offerings, they may join the penitent confession of their manifold sins, whereby they had forfeited every favour, and their humble and earnest supplication that it may please God, through the merits of Jesus Christ, mercifully to forgive and blot them out of remembrance; ...

## THANKSGIVING IN AMERICA

...That it may please Him, to prosper the trade and manufactures of the people, and the labour of the husbandman, that our land may yet yield its increase; to take school and seminaries of education, so necessary for cultivating the principles of true liberty, virtue and piety, under His nurturing hand, and to prosper the means of religion for the promotion and enlargement of that kingdom which consisteth "in righteous, peace and joy in the Holy Ghost."

NOW THEREFORE, I do recommend and aflign THURSDAY, the TWENTY-SIXTH DAY of NOVEMBER next, to be devoted by the people of thele States, to the fervice of that great and glorious Being, who is the heneficent Author of all the good that was, thac -is, F or that will be: That we may then all unile in rendering unto him our fincere and humble thanks for nis kind care and protedtion of the people of this country previous io their becoming a nation; for the fignal and roanifold mercies, and the favourable interpofitions of his Providence in tho courle and conclutiun of the lace war ;-..for the great degrec of tranquility, union and plenty, which we have fince enjoyed $;-$ for the peaceable and rational mannerin which we have been enabled to eftablim Conftiturions of Gevernment for our fafely and happinels, and paricularly the national one now lately inftituied ; $-\cdots$ for the civil and
